



What Happened

Next

The disaster killed 304 of the 476 people on board; 325 people were Danwon High School second-year students and staff on a pre-exam trip to Jeju Island. Only 75 students survived.

On April 19th, 2014, the Captain Lee Joon-seok was arrested on suspicion of negligence of duty, violation of maritime law and other infringements. Two other crew members, a helmsmen and the third mate, were also arrested on that day on suspicion of negligence and manslaughter.

By April 26th, 2014, twelve further arrests had been made with the whole crew responsible for navigation in detention.

On May 15th, 2014, Captain Lee Joon-seok, First Mate Kang Won-sik, Second Mate Kim Young-ho and Chief Engineer Park Gi-ho were indicted on charges of homicide through gross negligence. The other eleven crew members faced lesser charges of abandoning the ship and ship safety offences.

On November 11th, 2014, Captain Lee Joon-seok was acquitted of murder but found guilty of gross negligence and other charges and sentenced to 36 years in prison.

On April 17th, 2015, a day after the first anniversary of the sinking, 4,475 participants holding electronic candles formed the shape of the Sewol ferry at the commemoration event titled 'The Saddest Challenge in the World' in Seoul Plaza in front of City Hall.

On January 21st, 2017, an exclusive report revealed that BTS and Big Hit Entertainment were recently found to have donated 100 million won (approximately \$85,000) to the Sewol Ferry Disaster 416 Family Council. Each of the seven members contributed 10 million won (approximately \$8,500) and the agency added 30 million won (approximately \$25,500) to the total.

On March 23rd, 2017, the Sewol Ferry was pulled out with the aid of 450 people, 1073 days after it sank.

MODERN

KCN Modern team fits into UCLA's thriving hip-hop dance culture in a unique way. With open auditions, KCN Modern allows the opportunity for dancers from varying dance teams, skill sets, and cultural backgrounds to unite in celebrating Korean culture. The synchronization of each dancer immerses the audience in the production using dance as an art medium.



POONGMUL —

Poongmul, the art of traditional Korean percussion, explores existing historical aspects of Korean culture through diverse musicality. Poongmul exemplifies the concept of "breathing as one." Poongmul is meant to be a group endeavor, where drummers find unity through work ethics, discipline, and bonding. The bright costumes and the loud drumming bring our culture alive to UCLA.



The Korean traditional fan dance is based on the history of Chosun Dynasty court dances as well as ceremonial dances performed by shamans. Over the years, this popular form of traditional dance has been used at celebrations and gatherings. The dancers adorned in colorful traditional dresses, hanboks, use the fans to portray powerful floral imagery.

BBOY ——

Although members of the group originally premiered as a hip-hop collaboration with Poongmul during KCN 2009, KCN B-boys have become an official component of KCN recently. Formed by a close group of dancers who are bound by a passion for b-boying (also known as "breakdancing"), the KCN B-boys hope to express a highly skilled and intricate style of movements that is both visually stunning and mesmerizing
